We would consider these qualifications, taken together, to be comparable in academic level and purpose to the completion of the Ontario Secondary School Diploma (OSSD).

He continued his studies at Guru Nanak Dev University in Amritsar, India from 1995 to 1997. He completed the full program of studies (three years) and was awarded the degree of *Bachelor of Arts* with standing in the *Second Division* in 1997. Degrees are awarded in the First, Second or Third Division. Guru Nanak Dev University is a recognized institution and is a member of the Association of Commonwealth Universities. We would consider this qualification to be comparable in academic level and purpose to the completion of a Bachelor of Arts degree at a reputable Canadian university.

Mr. Sharma continued his studies at Punjab Technical University in Jalandhar, India and was awarded the degree of *Master of Business Administration (Information Technology & Systems)* with standing in the *First Division* in 2000. Punjab Technical University is a recognized institution. We would consider this qualification to be comparable in academic level and purpose to the completion of a four-year (Honours) Bachelor's degree at a reputable Canadian university.
